

Tofield Hockey Academy

What is the Tofield Hockey Academy?

The Tofield Hockey Academy is an alternative educational program where student athletes can focus on both academic achievement and individual development in hockey during the school day.

What are the Aims and Goals for this program?

To provide student athletes with the opportunity to complement their hockey skill development training that they are experiencing in the community. Our program gives students the opportunity to learn life skills in an environment that they love. In other words, we are using hockey as the vehicle to develop their academic and athletic potential to the fullest.

Who is eligible?

Designed for students, both male & female in grade 5-8, who are registered in Tofield School. Students must be able to interact positively with others, follow directions and be respectful. They must be “in good standing” both academically & behaviorally in all of their classes.

Structure of Program

At present, we anticipate the students will be on the ice 3 times a week with additional time spent in the classroom or in the training room. This will take the place of the students' regularly scheduled Physical Education and Health classes. Specific details of the program including teaching and staff & curriculum will be set once sufficient registration has been received to allow the program to operate.

Cost?

The preliminary cost will be \$300. A \$100 deposit must accompany the registration form. The remainder of the fees may be paid in two installments of \$100 Sept 30 & Nov 30. This covers ice-rental for the on-ice sessions, staffing equipment cost, jerseys, socks and insurance.
