

BOARD REPRESENTATIVES

The Board will give consideration to naming representatives to various external boards and/or committees (Schedule A). These representatives are designated at the discretion of the Board in order to facilitate the exchange of information on matters of mutual concern and/or to discuss possible agreements between the Board and other groups/organizations.

The Board will consider representation on District Committees (Schedule B) as requested by the Superintendent of Schools.

The Board will determine the terms of reference for designated representatives. The Superintendent may appoint resource personnel to work with representatives and shall determine roles, responsibilities and reporting requirements of resource personnel.

Trustees assigned to external boards and/or committees are responsible to provide a written report using the Conference/Professional Development Report form within two board meetings following an external board and/or committee meeting.
