ADMISSION OF EXPELLED STUDENTS

Background

The Division believes in providing a safe learning environment for students. School Administrator(s) in consultation with the Superintendent or designate will determine whether or not to accept registration at their school of students expelled from other school jurisdictions.

Procedures

- 1. A written statement of the student's expulsion must be presented to the School Administrator(s) of the receiving school. The student must obtain such a statement from the Principal of the expelling school.
- 2. In considering the possible admission of an expelled student residing in another jurisdiction, the Division shall:
 - 2.1 Deem the prospective student to be capable of benefiting from classroom instruction and school attendance.
 - 2.2 Deem that the conduct of the prospective student will not be injurious to the moral tone and/or general welfare of the school.
- 3. If the Division denies admission, the prospective student shall have the right to appeal that decision to the Board of Trustees.
