PARTICIPATION IN COMMUNITY / POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

Background

The Division recognizes the democratic right of employees to render public service and/or take an active part in community activities.

Procedures

- 1. The employee must maintain a level of job performance acceptable to their immediate supervisor and consistent with contractual obligations and employer expectations.
- 2. The employee must guard against becoming involved in activities which are interpreted as a conflict of interest.
- The employee considering public office or membership on government boards/agencies shall discuss any job related conflict of interest with the Superintendent or designate prior to making the decision to accept.
