## OUTREACH PROGRAMS

## Background

The Division believes there is a need to provide students an alternative to traditional school programming.

## Procedures

- 1. All students registering in an Outreach Program must have a referral form (218-1) completed by a Battle River School Division (BRSD) school administrator. If a student is not currently in a BRSD school, the Outreach Program school administrator must contact the prior school's administration.
- 2. All students registering in an Outreach Program must complete a student registration form (320-1).
- 3. An Online/Outreach student is expected to complete a minimum of two courses per semester.
- 4. An Online/Outreach student is encouraged to return to regular school programs as soon as they are ready. Some students may stay in an Outreach Program to complete their high school diploma.
- 5. A student's right of participation in an Outreach Program can be terminated for failure to comply with program expectations.
- 6. The Division reserves the right to place a student in an Outreach Program.
