

OUTREACH PROGRAMS

Background

The Division believes there is a need to provide students an alternative to traditional school programming.

Procedures

1. All students registering in an Outreach Program must have a referral form (218-1) completed by a Battle River School Division (BRSD) school administrator. If a student is not currently in a BRSD school, the Outreach Program school administrator must contact the prior school's administration.
2. All students registering in an Outreach Program must complete a student registration form (320-1).
3. An Online/Outreach student is expected to complete a minimum of two courses per semester.
4. An Online/Outreach student is encouraged to return to regular school programs as soon as they are ready. Some students may stay in an Outreach Program to complete their high school diploma.
5. A student's right of participation in an Outreach Program can be terminated for failure to comply with program expectations.
6. The Division reserves the right to place a student in an Outreach Program.
