Student Success

At the Board meeting, Round Hill students presented to the Board about the Round Hill Renaissance Agricultural Foundation, a community driven project that provides curriculum aligned educational programming to Round Hill School students.

Kindergarten students, Beau and Corbin, Leo (Grade 1) and Matilda (Grade 2), along with Kindergarten teacher, Courtney Schwab and Kyle Nahirniak (parent), spoke about the purpose of the program which supports teachers to deliver agricultural and land based lessons and students to authentically interact with the local environment.

Joint Use and Planning Agreement

The Board has approved the Joint Use and Planning Agreement (JUPA) between BRSD and the Village of Alliance, and between BRSD and the Village of Holden.

As the Education Act (S 53.1) requires, school divisions must enter into a JUPA under section 670.1 of the Municipal Government Act with each municipality within which the school division operates. The deadline to complete these is June 2025.
